Arrivals:	The conference will take place at The Jarrett Cricket Centre. Registration and teas/coffees will be served in The Long Room at 9.30am before the event begins at 10am. Enter through the Main Gate, turn right when you get to the mini roundabout and follow this road until you reach The Jarrett Cricket Centre (blue arrow on campus map).
Please bring:	This conference has both theoretical and practical sessions. Please ensure you bring cricket clothing and equipment, including a bat, pads, gloves and helmet. Willingness to participate in the practical sessions is appreciated but anyone who feels unable to do so is welcome to watch. Lunch will be provided. The conference will finish at 3.30pm.

Location and Directions

By Car

Enter through the Main Gate (see orange arrow on campus map below), turn right when you get to the mini roundabout (yellow arrow) and follow this road until you reach The Jarrett Cricket Centre (blue arrow). Parking spaces are available at the Cricket Centre.



Please note: Ignore local signs to Cobham as Reed's School is situated nearer to Oxshott than Cobham.

From the M25 anti-clockwise:

Exit at Junction 10 and join the A3 towards London. Travel for approximately five miles to the second intersection (signposted Esher, Leatherhead) and exit **right** to join the A244 travelling towards Leatherhead and Oxshott. Take the first turning on the right onto Sandy Lane (before you reach Oxshott Station and village). Reed's School is about half a mile down Sandy Lane on the left-hand side.

From the M25 clockwise:

Exit at Junction 9 and join the A244 Leatherhead/Esher road and continue through Oxshott Village. Take the first turning on the left

past Oxshott Station onto Sandy Lane. Reed's School is about half a mile down Sandy Lane on the left-hand side.

From the A3:

From London on the A3 - about five miles before the Junction to join the M25, you will see the A244 signpost. Take the first exit from this junction (signposted towards Leatherhead and Oxshott). Travel a short distance along the A244, then take the first turning **right** into Sandy Lane (before you reach Oxshott Station and village). Reed's School is about half a mile down Sandy Lane on the left-hand side.

From Portsmouth or Guildford on the A3 - travel towards London and take the second intersection past the M25 Junction (signposted Esher, Leatherhead) and exit right to join the A244 travelling towards Leatherhead and Oxshott. Take the first turning on the **right** onto Sandy Lane (before you reach Oxshott Station and Village). Reed's School is about half a mile down Sandy Lane on the left-hand side.

By Train and Bus

The nearest train station to Reed's School is Oxshott Station which is a 10-15 minute walk, or 5 minutes in a taxi. Oxshott Station is on the Waterloo/Guildford via Cobham Line.
